

The plot of the story was a good one, if somewhat predictable. The main characters were interesting and easy to cheer for.Why, then, am I only giving it two stars?First, the writing was just okay.Second, it's absurd to the point of being ridiculous that nearly all characters in the story mysteriously turn out to be gay. If it's a story about a group of characters working for a gay-friendly organization or for an LGBTQ cause it would make perfect sense (see Melissa Brayden's Soho Loft Series). But when the story is about two women reconnecting in a small American town, it leaves the reader incredulous. Not everyone's mother, grandmother, sister, best friend, daughter, and

daughter's best friend is going to be a lesbian. There are so many truly excellent lesbian romances now available (see anything written by Melissa Brayden, Carsen Taite, Dakota Hudson, Nell Stark, to name just a few) that it will be hard for Lakeville to compete.

Yes, they fell in love quickly like one reviewer stated, but you never forget your first love. I really liked the story and is worth a read. Only complaint was I wish it were longer. Will read this author again. Good job!
