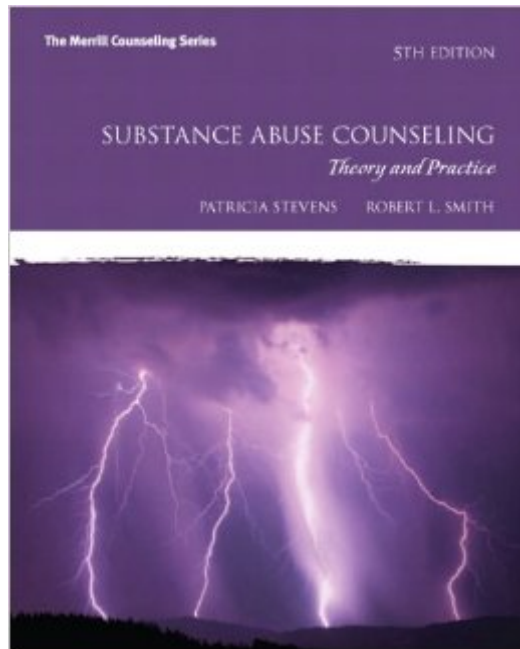

I just finished a graduate level course on substance abuse counseling, and this was my text. It's a pretty good textbook, with a lot of good information. Most of it is pretty dry reading though. Like a lot of graduate level textbooks, it's written in a dry yet information-dense style, which makes information

retention challenging. The best chapters by far are 1 - histories of various drugs of abuse, and 2 - their effects on the body. I wasn't very fond of the sample cases they had in the text. I would have preferred a lot of "real life" case studies, with the interventions that were attempted, alternative interventions suggested by other experts, and outcomes.

I ordered this book from LLC and received a "new" copy that did NOT contain the lab access code. I had to contact customer service and have another one delivered only to find out that the second copy also did not include the code. I ended up having to buy the access code from the Pearson website and it costs an additional \$40. You're better off buying the book with the lab code from your campus bookstore.

This book provides a wealth of information on substance and alcohol abuse. It is an interesting and informative book. It gives an overview of common substances and their affects on the body. Case studies provide practical application for concepts presented in the book. Must have for those working in the substance abuse field or those who just want to learn more.

As promised, I received a very clean copy of this textbook within a week. As I flipped through the pages, I found the topics interesting and easy to grasp. Although classes won't start for another three weeks, I'm already into it because so far, it's presented the right way: serious with a dash of lightheartedness. It's packed with useful information and knowledge that leaves an impression. I've already shared some of it's factual humor with a friend.

This is a good start up book. I actually bought this book for an introduction to addiction class that I was in but it can take me much further. It not only deals with assessment and treatment but it also introduces some basic knowledge on the different theories of substance abuse and on the major drugs abused.

So far, this book is informative and I like it, though the stats can be dull reading at times. Stats are, for me, somewhat of an intrusion in the narrative, and should be in a separate section. Otherwise, well worth the price.

The book is well written. It provides the reader with an easy reading experience while still providing the necessary information about substance abuse. I definitely recommend it for anyone who is looking to learn more about substance abuse.
