


Medical School For Everyone: Pediatrics Grand Rounds

This is my book suggestion of the day. I did it as an Audible audio book - and it is a good intro to the

value of audiobooks (good narration). This was the third I have done by this author, and I am a pretty big fan. It is part of Audible's "Great Courses" series, which is formatted like a series of lectures you would see in a college or grad school environment (only no homework or tests, and you only listen to what you want to listen to). The ones this author did are meant to replicate "rounds" that med students and interns might do... going patient to patient and reviewing the history and complaint and working through the possibilities to a diagnosis and treatment.Dude is a pediatrician, and he is very good at explaining things at the right level - not condescending (don't shake a baby) and not so technical that you need an organic chemistry background to follow him. I think this is in the top 3 most useful kid/baby/pregnancy books I have come across - explaining with some context what is worth a peds appointment, what is worth a trip to the ER (ED), and what is worth a 911 call.I think its a must if you're a parent, a teacher, or interested in medical and first aid stuff. If you hate kids and want nothing to do with them - check out his Emergency Medicine book or his general Grand Rounds book.As a bonus, he doesn't just talk about fevers and colds, but a pediatrician's eye view of good parenting and rule enforcement, and how to handle the curveballs life and kids throw at you.
