

I received this book the Friday before I took the Praxis II for Elementary Ed Content Knowledge (I had scheduled to take it that following Monday). I was pretty nervous that I wouldn't have enough time to study so I threw myself right into doing the practice tests provided in the guide. I corrected my practice exams and and made sure to look up and review any questions I wasn't familiar with or that I answered incorrectly. Quite a bit that I had reviewed ended up being on my test and since so many people had told me that the Praxis II was ridiculously hard, I couldn't help but feel confident

that I had done fairly well.Long story short: I recently learned that I passed it on my first try! I give this book 5 stars and definitely recommend it to anyone looking for a Praxis II study guide. I wasn't disappointed.

I purchased this study guide because I didn't find the one from ETS very helpful at all. This book had specific information, facts, that needed to be learned for the test, explanations of math rules and procedures, and finally some good test taking advice. As I was taking the test I realized just how helpful this study guide was. If you need to prepare for a PRaxis test, this is the study guide you need!

This book was incredibly helpful! I originally purchased the ETS study guide, but I found that book to be completely useless. I purchased this book since I saw it had several good reviews on .com. This book covered all of the material, and the practice tests were really helpful. I used only this book and passed the exam (with a score of 194/200) on my first try. This book is the best!

I ordered the secrets e-book for Elementary Content knowledge... I read and studied it for about 5 hours in the car on a road trip to visit family. When I came back I took the test and scoered in the top 10%. ETS even sent me a certificate for doing so well

I procrastinated and didn't order the printed book in time to study, so I ordered the e-book version. The four content areas are broken down into the major ideas covered on the exam. I read through the book the day before the exam and answered the sample questions. The next day I went over any incorrect answers and studied those sections again. I scored well over passing for all states. Should I need to test in another content area in the future, I will be ordering a study guide from Mometrix.

I've been out of school for 20 years and just took the Praxis 5014 and scored 184!!! I used this book and Praxis II Elementary Education (0014/5014) by Shannon Grey as review tools. There are a few answers wrong, but overall it is a good book. I studied for 2 hours a day, 5 days a week, for 2 weeks. I would recommend getting this book along with another one. Good Luck!!

I purchased this book to help me with the Praxis II Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects (5031) test and held on to it while I was finishing the semester. At the end of the semester, I went to

register for the test and found out the only date left for the test in my area was in five days and I was very worried.So I used the book and took the diagnostic test along with studying all four subjects (reading/language, math, social studies, and science). My state requires at least 165 in reading/language and math, 155 in social studies, and 159 for science. I scored no lower than 175 in all subjects and even got 197 on social studies. This book helped immensely in refreshing me on concepts that are taught in elementary education and I am extremely happy I had it during crunch time to take my test. Only gave it a four stars because there are a few typos I noticed in the book along with it being spotty in some areas like ESL concepts in the reading/language area. Other than that, it helped a ton and is worth the price.

Studied this for a couple of hours on three or four different occasions - most time spent on the practice exams and studying what I got wrong on the exam to make sure I was prepared. I also read the first couple of chapters and skimmed the titles of each section to get an idea of what to expect. I ended up getting maybe one wrong in math, science and language, and only a couple wrong in social studies - earning me some top score recognition certificate for being one of the top scorers in the entire history of the exam. Sure, it's only elementary ed, but if you haven't covered this material or used it in years, a refresher is definitely necessary. This was my first time taking the exam and I hadn't taken any basic education courses in about 20 years. I give this book mad cred for making sure I was prepared by studying the right things the first time.
